

Synopsis on the work with the teacher's guide

EuroSkills is the perfect study event for students who are at the point of choosing their career path. GR Skola Arbetsliv as a part of the Gothenburg Region Association of Local Authorities received the assignment to create a study guide for teachers so that students could prepare and make the most of their visit to EuroSkills. The study guide is financed by Skolverket (The National Education Agency). The guide is currently only available in Swedish.

This educational guide is intended for teachers and has been designed to be an aid in the school's efforts to give students the tools they require to examine different options and make decisions on issues concerning their own future. All the exercises have clear links to the curriculum in order to make the visit an effective yet natural part of the education.

The teacher's guide is divided into four educational themes:

- My dreams and goals.
- What is the job description?
- My studies.
- My working life.

The idea is that you can use the material to immerse in an educational theme or you can choose freely amongst the different exercises in the teaching guide. Each educational theme has a clear link to EuroSkills with exercises that you can perform during the event.

The format is constructed to provide teachers with a helping hand whilst also reassuring the importance of such an educational event. Although many teaching themes require different approaches they all converse future, career and educational choices alike. In today's society, where the labour market is constantly changing and where the education system is more complicated than ever before the information and event material should help students to make informed choices for now and into the future.

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
